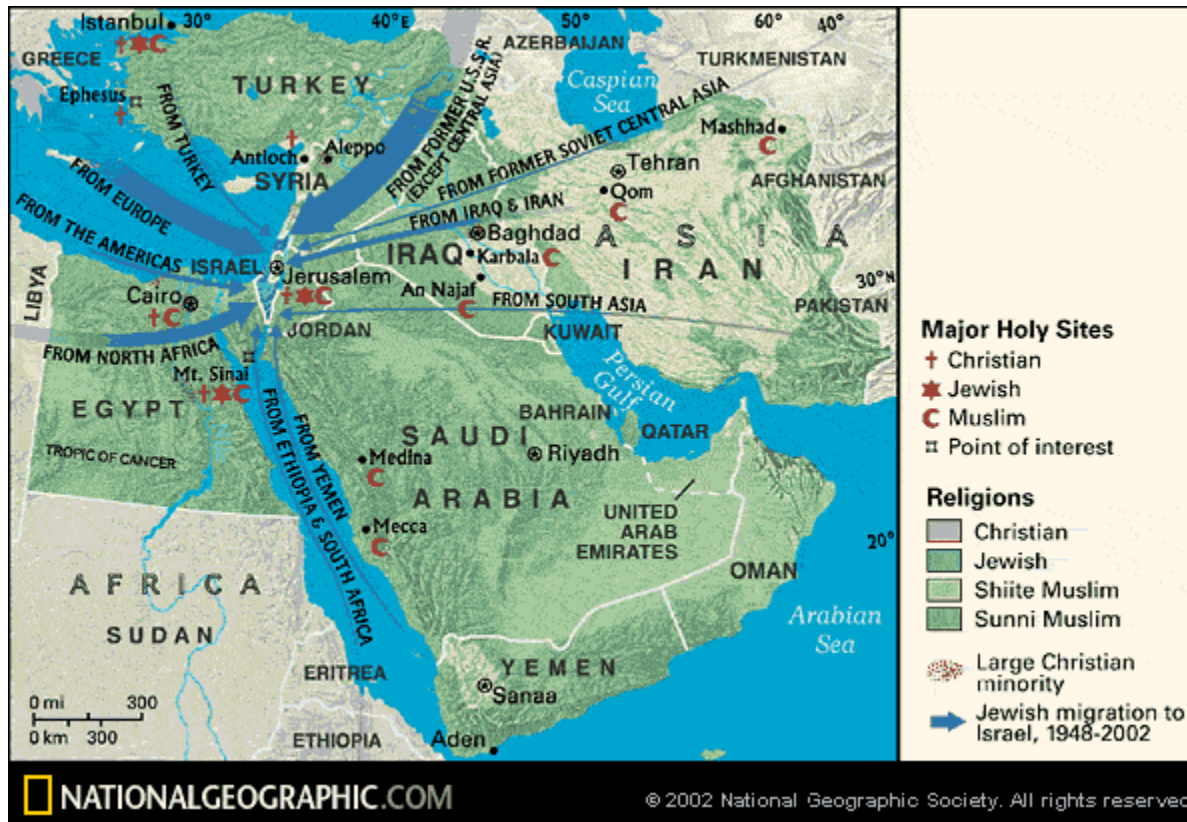


STATION 4: MOVEMENT

4. Circle Map: Cultural Diffusion occurs through the exchange of ideas. In what ways do human exchange ideas/communicate?

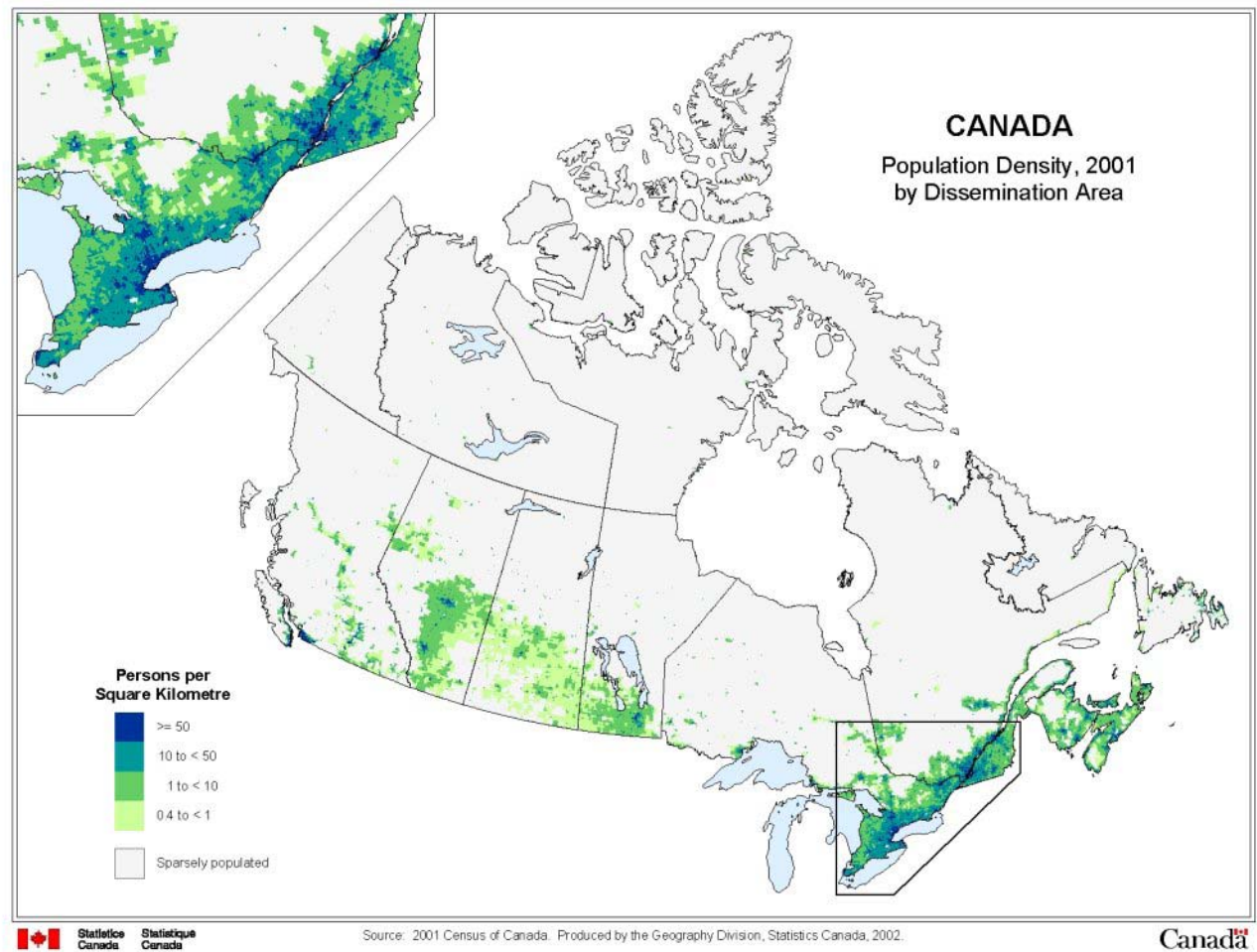
