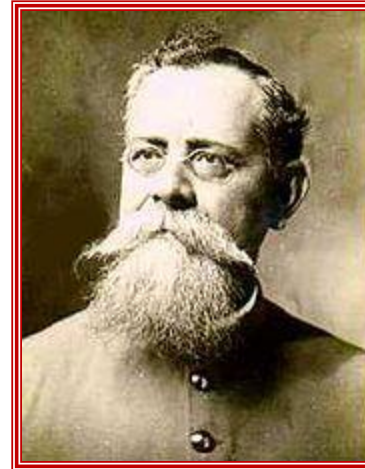


**FINAL REVIEW**

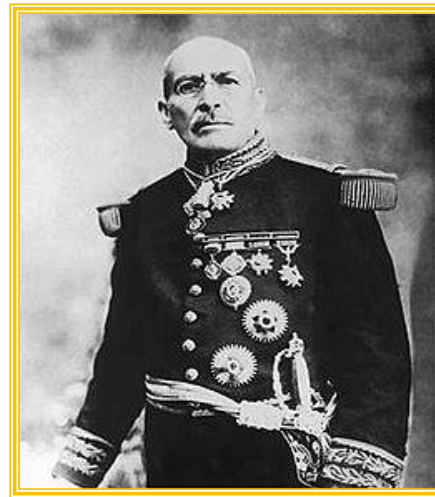

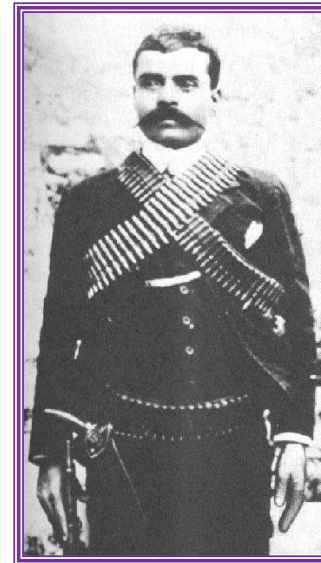

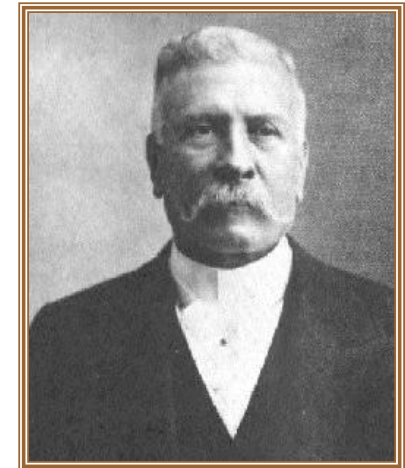
